Düsseldorf – The venue of the conference in the year 2015 is going to be Düsseldorf, Germany.

Düsseldorf with its scenic location along the Rhine river, is the capital of North Rhine-Westphalia, and is a major centreofservices and trade in the heart of Europe, a bustling, modern city with a population of 570,000.

In 2011 the quartet of technology trade fairs closed right on target after five trade fair days in Düsseldorf. The trade fairs achieved new records both in terms of exhibitors and visitors. 1,958 exhibitors from across the world met with 79,000 visitors from 83 countries.
